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Client Implementation Pilot

The pilot program was conducted between April 15, 2025 – April 19, 2025, by granting access to the eLearning training course to four participating secondary educators in Nebraska. Prior to participant involvement, the course was fully implemented within the Learning Management System (LMS) Instructure Canvas. The purpose of the pilot was to assess the course's effectiveness in achieving learning outcomes and to evaluate participant satisfaction.
